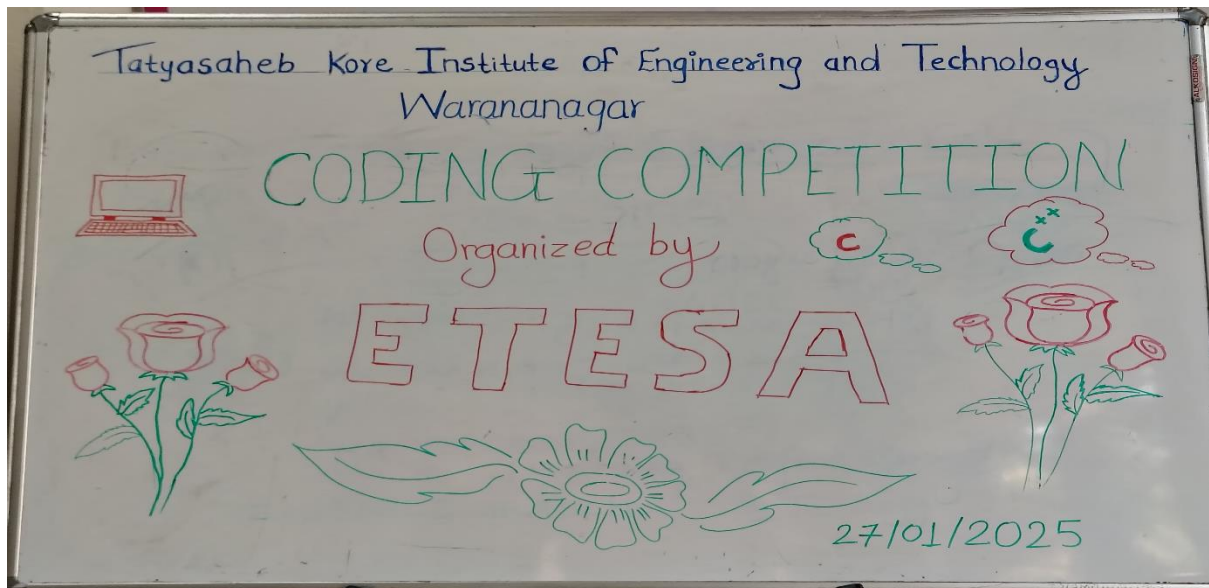

ETESA hosted a highly anticipated coding competition aimed at promoting problem-solving skills, logical thinking, and creativity among students. The event brought together participants from various disciplines, providing them an opportunity to showcase their coding abilities and compete against their peers. Objectives of the Event

- To enhance coding and algorithmic skills among students.
- To foster collaboration and networking between students from different departments.
- To create a platform for students to solve real-world technical problems through coding.
- To recognize and reward outstanding coding talent.

Event Format

The competition followed a structured format that included Two rounds:

Preliminary Round:

Participants were required to solve MCQ type Quiz of programming related Questions under a strict time limit. The questions ranged from basic Programming language C, C++, Java, Python. The participants were judged based on the correctness and efficiency of their solutions. Top 25 Students were qualified for second round.

Final Round:

The final round featured the top participants who got minimum 15 marks in first round. The top performers from the preliminary round advanced to this stage, where they faced more difficult challenge. This round tested their knowledge of advanced problem-solving strategies. The challenge of final round was to solve Pascal's Triangle in any language on Hacker Rank platform. Time for this round was 1 Hr. Top three participants among 25 were awarded with medal and certificate.

Judging Criteria:

The competition was judged based on the following criteria:

Correctness: Whether the solution produces the correct output for all test cases.

Efficiency: The time and space complexity of the solution, with preference given to optimal solutions.

Creativity: Innovative approaches to solving the problems were highly encouraged.

Code Readability: The clarity, organization, and comments within the code.

The event saw a substantial turnout, with over 90 participants from different departments. The competition was open to all the students of TKIET to ensuring

diversity in participation. Spectators, including faculty members and fellow students, attended the event to support the participants and witness the intense coding challenges.

The top three winners of the competition were as follows:


The Vice president of ETESA Miss. Bhakti Yadav proposed a heartfelt thanks to all participants of the event and co-ordinators of ETESA.
